Store & Manufacturer Coupons

- 1) Create a Coupon
- 2) Set the value of the coupon
- 3) Identify which inventory items are valid for the coupon
- 4) Make sales by adding the coupon SKU to the invoice
- 5) Run Reports on how many coupons were used and how much revenue they generated

Discover Coupon Manager

Coupon Manager's coupons are actually inventory items with much more functionality than the standard CTRL-C(oupon) command applied at an invoice screen. The Coupon Form allows you to name and define an unlimited number of your own coupons.

(A) The coupon can be either a set percentage off or a set dollar value off.

(B) The coupon is valid only when specific criteria are met.

- Set an Expiration Date
- Determine which inventory items qualify by selecting SKUs, Departments, Categories, or even Vendors
- Distinguish between Store and Manufacturer coupons so that you collect the proper sales taxes.

(C) Assigning the coupon to a category facilitates comprehensive reports based on date range, categories, and departments.

(D) Options to not apply the coupon to items already being discounted with price

breaks and/or promo pricing keeps profits in your pocket.

(E) Save time and money by flagging “excluded” items which should not be discounted even if all other items in the category qualify.

How Coupons Are Applied To The Invoice

When an invoice is created, you simply scan the SKU of one or more coupons which are predefined in this Coupon Manager list.

- TIP: set an Invoice Button to call up frequently used coupons.
- If qualifying items are on the invoice, then either the line Discount field or a Dollar Value will be calculated and added to the invoice.
- The coupon can be added at any time, and the line entry will be updated as more qualifying items are added to the invoice.

Need Coupons? Print Coupons On Demand

Or, you could design a fancy inventory label to include your company name and logo and print them to a laser or color ink jet printer.

PRM is built around Microsoft’s SQL, a robust and scalable database. SQL allows PRM to work with many popular third-party programs such as Crystal Reports. All the familiar features of PFW are still there, but with an improved, streamlined user interface.

PRM boasts several new features: Touchscreen support is built-in and now utilizes “Fast Tender”; Advanced Search rapidly finds customers and inventory; Combine Same SKU saves receipt paper; store Divisions categorize sales; invoices and reports convert to PDF documents; and data can be exported to various formats.

Enhanced multi-store functionality gives the master store access to ALL data and data replication allows off-line computers to sync with the server at reconnect. Discover POSitive Reminders, Customized Printing with Crystal Reports, and the new POSitiveCommerce with fully integrated credit card processing.
